

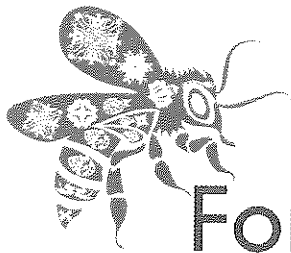

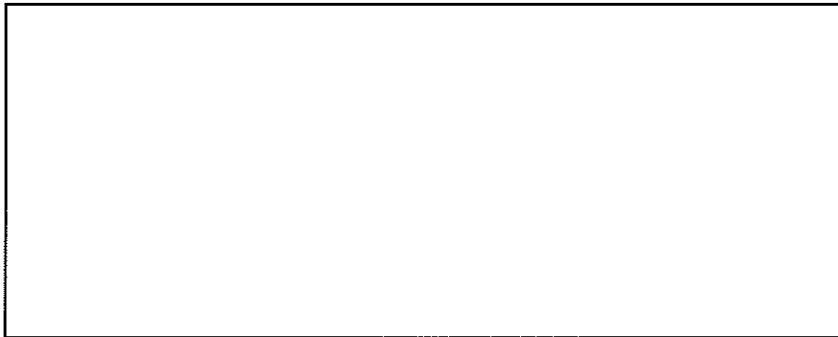

 - The setting.
 - The general plot of the series.
 - The arc of most episodes (what is generally happening in every episode)
